- Turn right on Copia, till you get to N. Copper Rd. turn left. The road takes you into the Park.

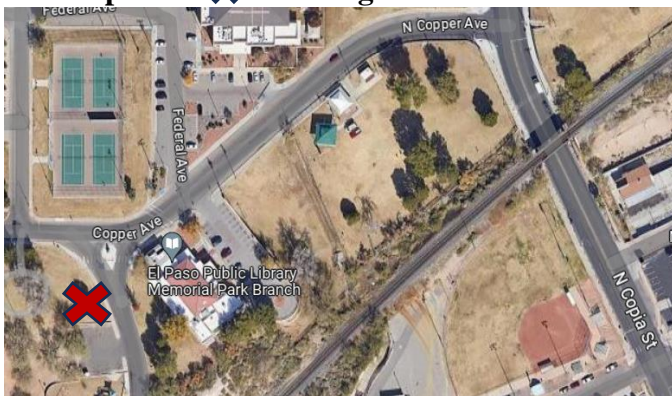
******Travel on N. Copper Road**
